

LAKE QUINAULT LODGE FACT SHEET

LOCATION	Lake Quinault Lodge is just 3 hours from Seattle and only 3-1/2 hours from Portland. From I-5 North or South, take exit 104 at Olympia (Aberdeen-Ocean Beaches) and head straight west to Aberdeen-Hoquiam. From Hoquiam, go north on U.S. 101 for 40 miles to milepost 125. Turn right on South Shore Road and go 2 miles to Lake Quinault Lodge.

OVERVIEW	Built in 1926 on the shores of Lake Quinault, within the heart of one of only three temperate rain forests in the world, Lake Quinault Lodge is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is a rustic retreat in the Pacific Northwest. With access to more than 250 miles of hiking trails in the Quinault Valley – 15 miles of which are within walking distance of the lodge – Lake Quinault Lodge is the perfect starting point for exploring the emerald green forests and surrounding wildlife on and around the lake.

DINING

Roosevelt Dining Room – In the fall of 1937, President Franklin D. Roosevelt visited Lake Quinault Lodge during a fact-finding trip and enjoyed lunch in the later-named Roosevelt Dining Room. Nine months later, Roosevelt signed a bill creating Olympic National Park. Today you'll enjoy outstanding cuisine in the Roosevelt Dining Room, as well as panoramic views of the Lake and the mountains beyond. The Roosevelt Dining Room serves traditional Pacific Northwest fare. The restaurant is open year-round for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Van Tours

Rainforest Van Tour- Rainforest tours are conducted year round in our Quinault Rainforest. This private van tour will help you discover the beauty, and peace of this magnificent wild resource. Our retired ranger guide takes you to the best photo points in the area and you will experience the forest up close and personal on walks at specific locations on this 3-hour tour. The tour can accommodate 5 people. Reservations are taken at the front desk of the lodge.

June 15 - September 15 Schedule:

Wild Olympic Beaches Tour- Olympic National Park has some of the most pristine wild beaches on the Washington coast. This guided tour will take you on a half day of fun and exploration to view beautiful tide pools where amazing and colorful creatures live at the edge of the sea. Some spend their entire life firmly attached to a rock they call home, while others drift in the surf. We will explore 2 separate beaches of totally different characters, and visit the amazing and mysterious burl forest.

June 15 - September 15 Schedule:

Daily: 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m., Adults \$30, Children under 12 \$10. Six years old and under, Free

Fishing – Lake Quinault is a great place for steelhead and trout fishing.

Boat rentals and tours – There are many wonderful ways to explore the tranquil waters of Lake Quinault. Scenic boat tours (available seasonally) take approximately 90 minutes and offer breathtaking views of the lake and surrounding Olympic Mountains. We also offer spectacular lake tours from the comfort of our captained boats:

Day Break Lake Tour

This is the perfect way to start your day in the Quinault Rain Forest. The lake is normally very calm and one may see Bald Eagles and Osprey fishing as well as River Otters. It is an educational tour about the area including the vistas, the rain forest, wildlife, fisheries, the creation of the National Parks and National Forests, tribal life, the explorers and pioneers.

Evening Lake Tour

The same great tour as the Day Break Tour however this tour offers you the opportunity to learn about the area upon your arrival so that you get started early the next morning hiking and visiting giant trees etc. The tour is a great orientation to the Quinault Rain Forest and an excellent way to "Wine" down your evening before dinner.

Sunset Lake Tour

After dinner relax aboard our comfortable tour boat and enjoy a cruise around beautiful Lake Quinault. We leave at 7:00 from the dock and return about 1 ½ hours later. We may see Bald Eagles catching the last fish of the day or River Otters playing near the shoreline. Our sunsets can be spectacular. This tour is not heavy on narration, though we can certainly address your questions, and is intended to help you wind down your day in the Quinault rain forest.
