Join us for this 3 hour comprehensive tour of America's Rainforest at Lake Quinault. Your guide will take you to the best photo points and you will get close to the rainforest on selected short walks. All 3 temperate rainforests in the contiguous United States are located on the Olympic Peninsula. This 30 mile tour takes you deep into Olympic National Forest and Olympic National Park. Rain soaked mosses adorn the Big Leaf Maples and waterfalls cascade into pools where young salmon can be seen jumping into the air from their watery world.

Roosevelt Elk, named in honor of Teddy Roosevelt, are abundant here and are frequently seen on this tour. Bald Eagles return in large numbers each fall to enjoy their annual salmon dinner as the salmon spawn and succumb to the rigors of their long journey.



The Quinault area offers a unique opportunity to stay "IN" the rain forest, with no commute, and be accommodated in lodges and resorts while embracing the natural beauty all around you. Whenever you visit, the Quinault Rain Forest will always present you with intense beauty and wonderful seasonal changes. Our waterfalls are at their peak in the rainy season so bring your camera and let's go explore
